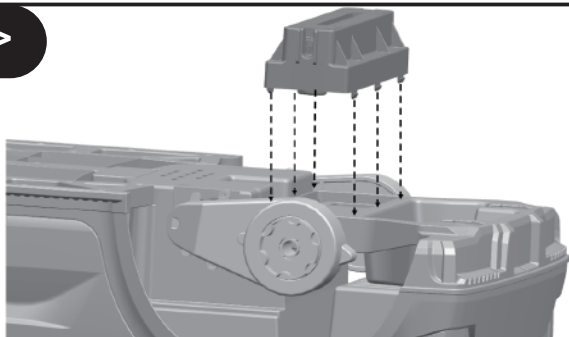
1. Turn over the body and find the gearbox, then cut the ties.

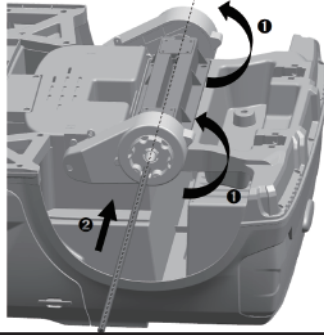
2. Release the two nuts with the tools provided, and pull the wheel axle out.

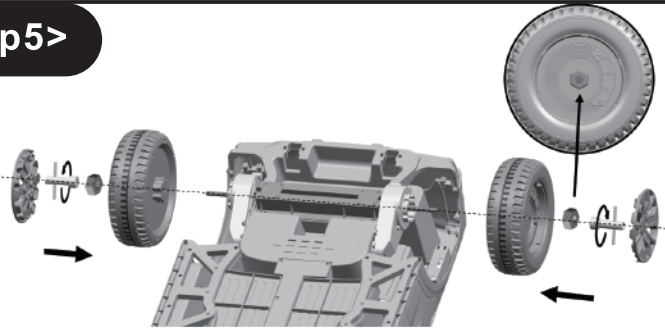
3. Place the rear support into the position of the body, make sure it is firmly fixed.

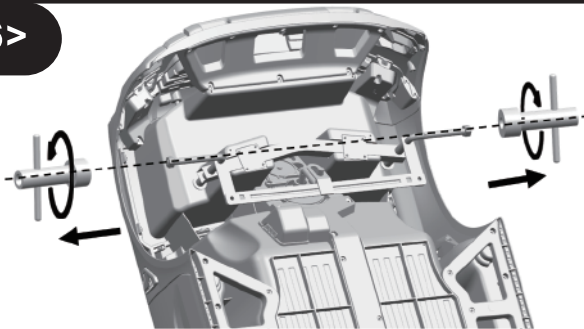
4. Rotate the gearbox and make the hole alignment, then insert the rear wheel axle.

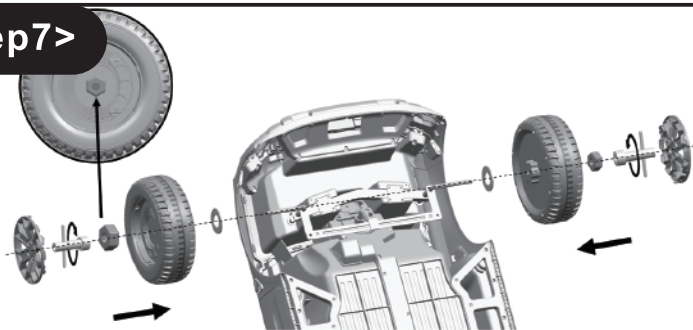
5. Insert the two wheels first and tighten with two nuts by the tools provided, then cover the wheel caps.

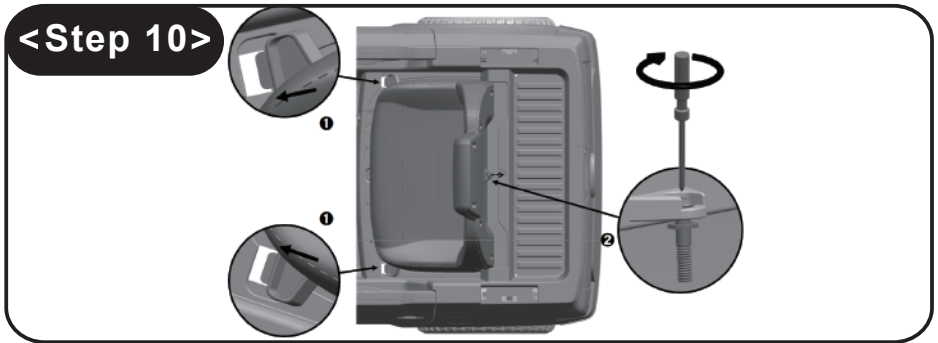


8.Insert the windshield in the front of the body,make sure it is firmly fixed.

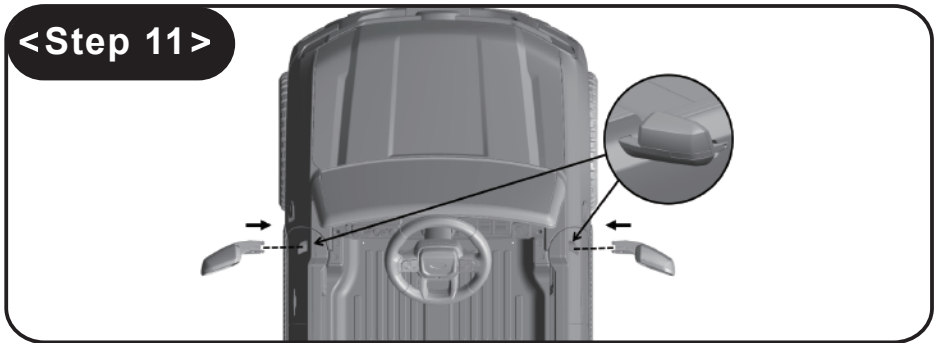

9.Press the button and insert the steering wheel.



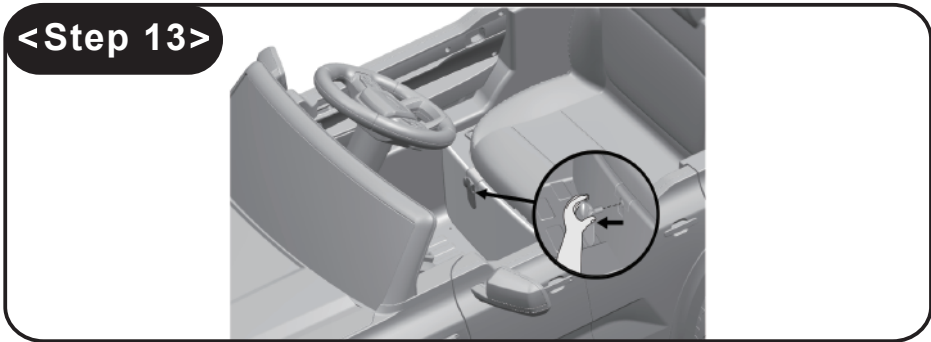
10. Place the front of the seat first, then close the rear of the seat, tighten by a screw with a screwdriver(not included).

12. Place the bracket into the rear of the body.

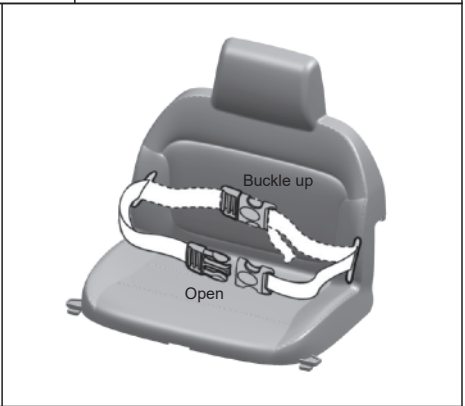
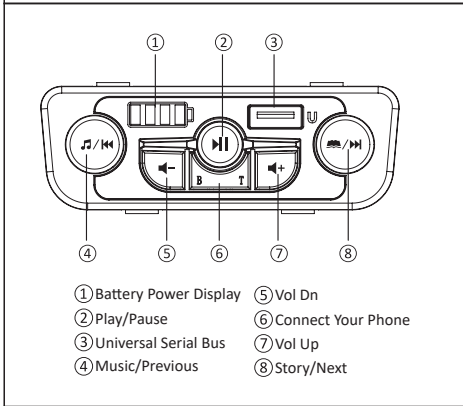
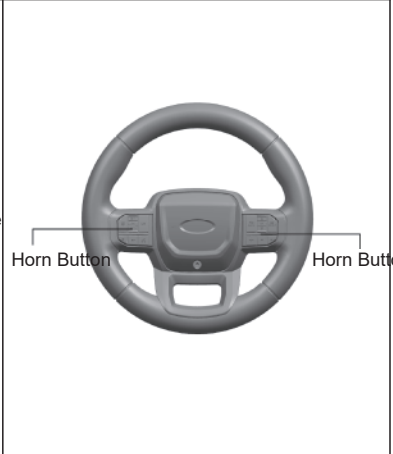
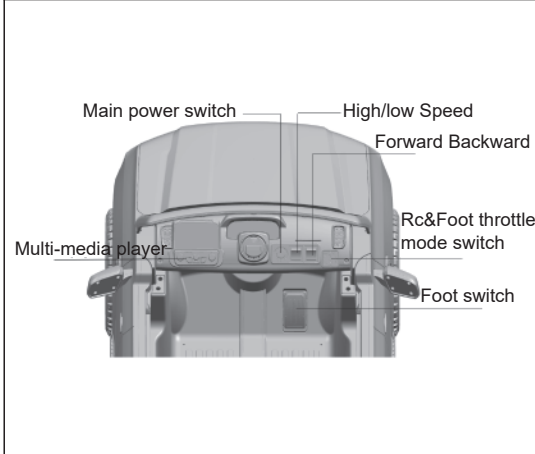
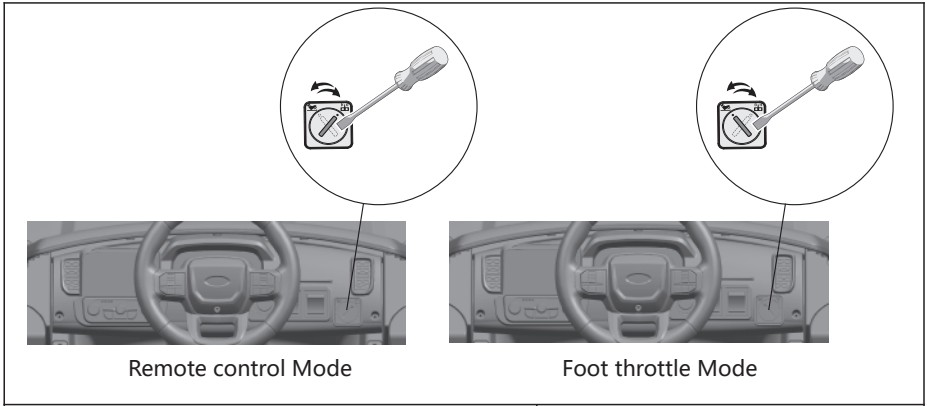

VI.Charging the Drive Battery .

1. The charging socket is located at the lower part of the car seat.
2. Only battery and charger which are provided or recommended can be used only.
3. Please do not play with the charger and battery because they are not toys.
4. The battery charging operation is to be carried out only by adults.
5. The battery shall be fully charged before first use; the battery charging time shall be 9-10 hours and can not exceed 15 hours
6. It is normal for battery and charger to feel warm during charging.



VII.Simple Problem Diagnostic.

Defective conditions	Key points of inspection
1. The car can not be driven.	1) Ensure the power switch, all plugs of the control plate under the seat, and the battery terminal line are properly inserted.
	2) Ensure the over current protector, when the car is over loaded or blocked, the over current protector automatically disconnects the circuit to protect the motor and controlling IC board.
	3) Check whether the car has been stored for a long time and its battery is not charged on time.
	4) If the remote control cannot start the car, please check whether the remote control code-matching function is normally operated.
	5) Check whether the remote control battery power is low.
2. Music sound is distorted or silent	Check whether the battery has enough power, otherwise charge fully.

VIII. WARNING.

1. Battery warning:

- 1) When storing the car for a long time, fully charge the battery, then turn off the power. The battery should be recharged once every other month – minimising the risk of shortening its lifespan.
- 2) When installing the battery, the positive and negative poles must be correctly connected. Short circuiting of positive and negative poles could damage the product.
- 3) Product needs to be operated with two DC 1.5V AAA batteries (not included) and two DC1.5V AA batteries (not included).
- 4) Only adults should change batteries.
- 5) Recharging batteries must be done by adults.
- 6) Non-rechargeable batteries cannot be charged.
- 7) Before recharging chargeable batteries, ensure they are removed from the remote control.
- 8) Do not mix different types of batteries.
- 9) Do not mix old and new batteries.
- 10) When storing the car for a long time, ensure the batteries are removed.
- 11) Over-used batteries should be removed.

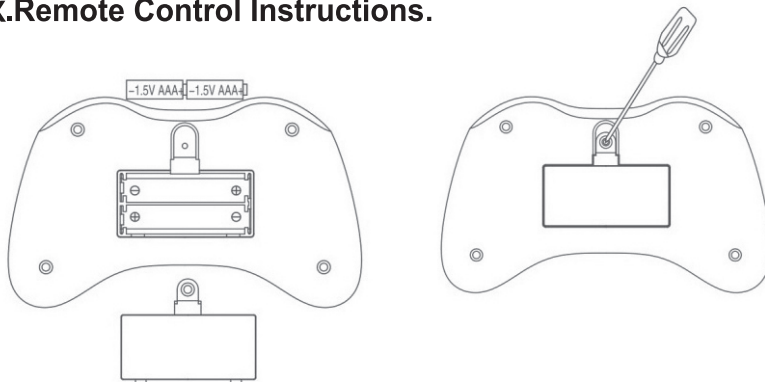

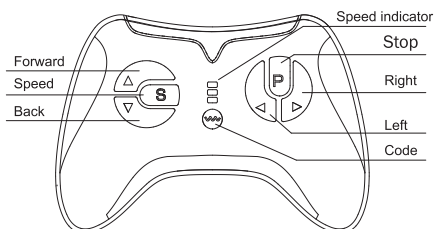

IX. Remote Control Instructions.



Loosen the screw with a screwdriver, and put 2 AAA batteries into the battery house.
Cover with a battery cover and tight with a screw



Operation manual: For the first time to use Need to frequency bind.

- First time use need to match code, this product has memory function
Replace battery is unnecessary match code
- Hold down “⚡” keys for 3 seconds start match code, The first LED flicker
- Turn on the car body power now, The first LED lit up, Match code Success
- Remoter 10 seconds not run will be standby ,Press any key wake up
- Keys caption : “△” Forward, “▽” Back, “◀” Left, “▶” Right, “S” Speed, “P” Brake.
Press “S” key set up speed , 1 led lit up is low speed, 2 leds lit up is medium speed ,
3 leds lit up is high speed, Back a car is only low speed
Press “P” key hold the brake, All LED flicker
△ The remote controller only can be used with adult's guidance

X. Care and Maintenance

- 1) Regularly wipe and clean it with a piece of cloth.
- 2) The rotating parts of the car should be checked regularly to determine whether any foreign matter obstructs the rotation and to keep the lubricating state of normal operation.

VI. Chargement de la batterie d'entraînement.

1. La prise de charge est située à la partie inférieure du siège
2. Seules la batterie et le chargeur fournis ou recommandés peuvent être utilisés.
3. Veuillez ne pas jouer avec le chargeur et la batterie car ce ne sont pas des jouets.
4. L'opération de charge de la batterie ne doit être effectuée que par des adultes.

VII. Diagnostic simple du problème.

Problèmes	Solutions Possibles

	2. Lorsque la voiture est surchargée ou bloquée, le protecteur de surintensité déconnecte automatiquement le circuit, protégeant ainsi le moteur et la carte de contrôle IC.
	3. Si la voiture a été rangée pendant un certain temps, la batterie est peut-être déchargée.
	4. Si la télécommande ne fonctionne pas, vérifiez si sa fonction de correspondance de code fonctionne normalement.
	5. Vérifiez si la pile de la télécommande est faible.

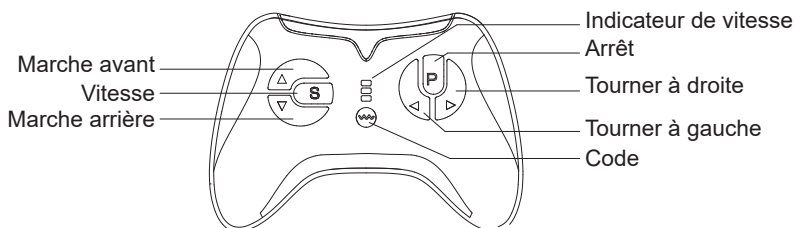


