

01. Never hang from the rim or climb on the pole as injury or property damage could occur. For these reasons do not perform dunking type activities on this system as it is not designed for such use. Do not allow children to climb on the basketball system.
02. Never leave the unit assembled without weight in the tank!
03. Check the tank frequently for leaks or a loose cap. Slow leakage could cause the system to tip over unexpectedly and damage the floor if used inside.
04. Climate, corrosion or misuse could result in system failure.
05. This system is not intended for children 3 and under.
06. To store the system: Drain the water from the tank and dismantle the system. Store in a dry ventilated place.
07. If technical assistance is required, contact our customer service department . Most injuries are caused by misuse and/or failure to follow instructions. Use caution when using the system.

▪ **POLE CARE AND SYSTEM MAINTENANCE:**

The life of your basketball system depends on many variables. The climate, exposure to corrosives such as salt, pesticides or herbicides and excessive use or misuse can all contribute to pole failure, which may cause property damage or personal injury.


Check your basketball system frequently for loose hardware, excessive wear and signs of corrosion. For safety reasons and to prolong the life of your basketball system, you must take the following preventive measures:

- a. Check all nuts and bolts. If any are loose, tighten them.
- b. Check all parts for excessive wear and tear. If necessary, replace any parts that have been worn or damaged through usage. Contact our customer service department for replacement parts.
- c. Inspect the warning sticker on the pole. If it is ripped, faded or illegible, call our customer service department to request a replacement sticker.
- d. Check all pole sections for visible rust, chipped or cracked paint. If either are present, do the following :
 1. Use an emery cloth to completely remove any rust or chipped paint.
 2. Clean the area with a damp cloth and allow it to dry.
 3. Apply two coats of a rust preventative, high gloss enamel to the area. Allow the paint to dry between two coats.


Important! It is not recommended to use the system outdoors in freezing / subzero conditions.

To drop the rim to 190cm you must remove a section of the pole.



1. Ne jamais s'accrocher au bord ou grimper sur le poteau, car cela pourrait entraîner des blessures ou des dommages matériels. Pour ces raisons, n'effectuez pas d'activités de type « dunking » sur ce système car il n'est pas conçu pour une telle utilisation. Ne permettez pas aux enfants de grimper sur le système de basket-ball.

2. Ne laissez jamais l'unité assemblée sans poids dans le réservoir !

3. Vérifiez fréquemment si le réservoir présente des fuites ou si le bouchon est desserré. Une fuite lente pourrait faire basculer le système de manière inattendue et endommager le sol s'il est utilisé à l'intérieur.

4. Le climat, la corrosion ou une mauvaise utilisation peuvent entraîner une défaillance du système.

5. Ce système n'est pas destiné aux enfants de 3 ans et moins.

6. Pour stocker le système : Vider l'eau du réservoir et démonter le système. Stocker dans un endroit sec et ventilé.

7. Si une assistance technique est nécessaire, contactez notre service clientèle. La plupart des blessures sont causées par une mauvaise utilisation et/ou le non-respect des instructions. Faites preuve de prudence lors de l'utilisation du système.

■ **ENTRETIEN DES POTEAUX ET MAINTENANCE DU SYSTÈME :**

La durée de vie de votre système de basket-ball dépend de nombreuses variables. Le climat, l'exposition à des produits corrosifs tels que le sel, les pesticides ou les herbicides et l'utilisation excessive ou abusive peuvent tous contribuer à la défaillance des poteaux, ce qui peut provoquer des dommages matériels ou des blessures.

Vérifiez fréquemment votre système de basket-ball afin de détecter tout matériel desserré, toute usure excessive et tout signe de corrosion. Pour des raisons de sécurité et pour prolonger la durée de vie de votre système de basket, vous devez prendre les mesures préventives suivantes :

a. Vérifiez tous les écrous et boulons. Si certains sont desserrés, serrez-les.

b. Vérifiez que toutes les pièces ne présentent pas d'usure excessive. Si nécessaire, remplacez toutes les pièces usées ou endommagées par l'utilisation. Contactez notre service clientèle pour obtenir des pièces de rechange.

c. Inspectez l'autocollant d'avertissement sur le poteau. Si s'il est déchiré, décoloré ou illisible, appelez notre service clientèle pour demander un autocollant de remplacement.


d. Vérifiez que toutes les sections du poteau ne présentent pas de rouille visible, d'écaillures ou de fissures de peinture :

1. Utilisez une toile émeri pour enlever complètement la rouille ou la peinture écaillée.


2. Nettoyez la zone avec un chiffon humide et laissez-la sécher.

3. Appliquez deux couches d'un émail brillant antirouille sur la zone. Laissez la peinture sécher entre les deux couches.


